## CLASS OF 2009 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Three (3) National Merit Scholars and One (1) National Merit Commended Scholar
- Seventeen (17) Oklahoma Academic Scholars
- Over 175 scholarships offered to the graduates of 2010
- The athletes of the graduating class of 2010 contributed to four (4) state academic championships
- **Art** – Five (5) senior AP portfolios were submitted, receiving two Scholastic Gold Key Awards and one Scholastic Silver Key Award
- **Art** – Three (3) art students were awarded State Superintendent Awards of Arts Excellence
- **Art** – Students won multiple awards at Brass Ring, Best of Show at the Genesis Competition, received 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> place at Young Talent of Oklahoma and one (1) student received a Mayfest Young Artists Award as well as students exhibiting pieces of art at Gilcrease Museum.
- **Athletics** – Cheerleading won a National Championship title in 2010
- **Athletics** – Ten (10) different sports teams competed in the state tournament with three second place finishes
- **Athletics** – State Champions in boys Tennis and also received three (3) individual Tennis State Championships
- **Athletics** – State Champion Runner-Ups in boys and girls Cross Country and boys Soccer
- **Athletics** – District and Regional championships were earned by basketball, baseball, cheer, cross country, football, soccer, tennis and track
- **Band** – High school band received Superior Ratings in performance and sight reading at the District Contest and a '2' in performance and a Superior Rating in sight-reading at State.
- **Drama** – Five (5) students were All Star Cast Members at the regional "One Act" competition; two (2) students were All-State cast members and one (1) was named a State Superintendent Winner. Drama also received the Outstanding Tech Award at regional competition.
